The California Maritime Security Council (CMSC) will be holding a meeting to hear updates on the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services, U.S. Coast Guard and Port initiatives on October 20, 2014.

The mission of the CMSC is to act as an advisory body to the Governor in matters related to Maritime Security as follows:

- Identifying areas where port partners can improve statewide collaboration and information sharing to identify potential threats; Identifying areas where institutionalized coordination through codified processes will enhance security, emergency response procedures, communications, coordinating contingency planning, and other areas of mutual responsibility across the State of California;
- Developing a statewide maritime security strategy;
- Preparing plans to quickly recover from a catastrophic event at a California port;
- Developing a strategy to enhance the baseline levels of preparedness that will increase the amount of homeland security funding California receives from the United States Department of Homeland Security;
- Identify the enhancement and implementation strategies necessary for the execution of security systems;
- Develop a strategy for recovery and continuity of operations;
- Develop a strategy for enhancement of the goods movement supply chain expanding beyond the ports.
